


Site Description	<p>The Annals of the Four Masters record a battle fought in 1197 AD on the strand, between the Cenel Conaill & and Anglo-Norman raiding party. A metal detector survey was carried out over 10 fields to see if any traces of the battle could be located, prior to construction of a gas pipeline through the area. The results proved to be very limited. Very little was found and all of the artefacts recovered were of very recent date. The battle site remains unlocated [ADS, 2003].</p>	
Landscape Context (setting)	The battle site area is located along the southern shores of Lough Foyle near Coolagh Bridge.	
Site Appraisal	An important historical 12 th century event is epitomised in this unlocated battle site.


